4. Michigan Antique Festival, Inc. assumes no responsibility for injury to any person, including patrons, patrons of Exhibitor, Exhibitor and family members, agents or employees; no loss or destruction of Exhibitor's property including property which Exhibitor has on loan or consignment from others on account of theft, loss, destruction, fire, wind, hailstorm, tornados, flooding, and any and all other natural causes or Acts of God and Exhibitor further agrees to be self-insured or provide own insurance and to further indemnify and hold harmless Michigan Antique Festival, Inc. for any and all claims arising under this paragraph;
