Spectators are paying to see a fully setup show. This will help the show continue to grow for everyone's benefit.
2. Only one set of "Gate Entry Paperwork" per registration. Each registration allows 1 car entry and up to 2 admissions at time of check-in (Extra Helpers, \$10 Each.) Others arriving later without paperwork will pay daily admission charges.
3. No illegal activity will be permitted on Lots or on Festival Grounds and Exhibitor agrees to abide by all state laws, local ordinances, rules and regulations;
4. Table covers must be used, Please NO bare tables.
5. No sale of food, beverages and/or alcohol from your booth or lot locations will be permitted on Festival Grounds under any circumstances;
6. Michigan Antique Festival, Inc. assumes no responsibility for injury to any person, including patrons, patrons of Exhibitor, Exhibitor and family members, agents or employees; no loss or destruction of Exhibitor's property including property which Exhibitor has on loan or consignment from others on account of theft, loss, destruction, fire, wind, hailstorm, tornados, flooding, and any and all other natural causes or Acts of God and Exhibitor further agrees to be self-insured or provide own insurance and to further indemnify and hold harmless Michigan Antique Festival, Inc. for any and all claims arising under this paragraph;
